Previous woodworking experience is a valuable asset but not a requirement for application - total beginners are very welcome to apply. We value enthusiasm and a clear dedication to learning above all else.

Course dates, hours and holidays

The course dates for 2026/2027 are below. You must be able to attend the whole program.

Classes run from 8am to 5pm every week day with an hour for lunch.

Start date: Mon August 24th 2026

End date: Fri May 28th 2027

Actual tuition period (minus all breaks and public holidays) is 32 weeks.

Course Cost

The cost for the 9 month Intensive Course in Fine Woodworking is \$24,400. This is payable in 3 installments due as follows:

1st installment:	\$8,140 due on August 10th 2026.
2nd installment:	\$8,130 due on 9th November 2026
3rd installment:	\$8,130 due on 8th February 2027

Your course fee covers tuition and material costs for all the set projects. Additional expenditure will be needed only for the material costs for self-designed projects. We will provide all the tools you need to complete the course but most students will want to gradually purchase their own hand tools as their experience increases.

Please be aware that the Two Rock School of Woodworking currently operates as a private school and has not yet been nationally recognized by an accrediting agency. This means that applications for state or federal assistance (Financial Aid, GI Bill, Student loans etc) are unlikely to be accepted. We do hope to gain accreditation in the future but do not expect it to be achieved for the 2026/27 academic year.
